AFFIRMATION OF CHRISTIAN MISSION AND SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSE

The mission of Regent University is *Christian Leadership to Change the World*. The Church Of God In Christ (COGIC) is a Church of the Lord Jesus Christ in which the word of God is preached, ordinances are administered and the doctrine of sanctification or holiness is emphasized, as being essential to the salvation of mankind. Therefore, in recognition of our shared visions, Regent University School of Law has established the COGIC Scholarship for qualified students affiliated with the COGIC who have demonstrated spiritual maturity, exceptional character, integrity and academic excellence.

THE COGIC 2010-2011 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Only students who are admitted to Regent Law and have submitted all required documentation will be considered for the scholarship (see checklist below). All materials submitted for admission including the personal statement, resume and faculty recommendations, will also be considered during the scholarship decision.

The COGIC 2010-2011 Scholarship is based on the following LSAT/UGPA criteria; however, final award decisions are subject to the discretion of the law school:

- 155 and above LSAT & 3.0 UGPA = between \$20,000 to full-tuition scholarship
- 150 to 154 LSAT & 3.0 UGPA = between \$10,000 to \$20,000 annual scholarship
- 145 to 149 LSAT & 3.0 UGPA = between \$5,000 to \$10,000 annual scholarship

THE COGIC 2010-2011 SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

- Submit a Regent University School of Law Admission Application for Fall 2010, available online at www.regent.edu/lawapplication.
- Submit a Regent Law School financial aid application online at www.regent.edu/lawfinances, and:
 - Check the box for the COGIC Scholarship
 - Enter the name of church membership and Jurisdictional Bishop in the "comments" box
- Provide a letter of recommendation from the applicant's Jurisdictional Bishop. This letter is in addition to the letters of recommendation required for admission, and may be received via mail or e-mail to the addresses below.

THE COGIC SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

Award levels for this scholarship significantly exceed those generally awarded for individuals in similar score ranges; therefore, recipients typically are not awarded supplementary law school scholarships or grants. The COGIC Scholarship renews annually at the previous amount provided the student maintains a spring cumulative grade point average of 2.75. All scholarships and grants are subject to the School of Law Financial Aid Policies & Procedures.
