## Regent University's Parking Policies

All Regent University faculty, staff, and students are required to register their vehicles and motorcycles with Parking Services. To apply for parking, please submit a General Parking Application at<u>www.regent.edu/parking</u>. Students can pick up parking decals from Student Services in SC 201 Monday through Friday between the hours of 8am and 5pm (6pm on Tuesdays). The sticker must be placed on the inside of the front windshield behins the rear view mirror, out of the line of sight. Stickers are non-transferable.

Violations: Parking violations are \$50 for most offenses; \$100 for parking in the Student Center lot without the proper hangtag; and \$150 for parking in a disabled spot. <u>Parking in the Student Center lot without the appropriate hangtag during enforcement hours will result in the vehicle being ticketed and/or towed.</u>

Reserved Spaces: Reserved spaces are enforced Monday—Friday between 6am and 6pm. <u>Parking in a reserved space without the appropriate hangtag during enforcement hours will result in the vehicle being ticketed and/or towed.</u>
