We are looking forward to your arrival at Regent! **The Designated Arrival Dates for students living in on-campus Student Housing for the Fall, 2012 semester are: Monday, August 6 and Tuesday, August 7, 2012.** The Office of International Student Services (OISS) may be able to coordinate airport pick-ups for new F-1 and J-1 international student visa holders between the hours of 8 a.m. – 11 p.m. on **Monday, August 6 and Tuesday, August 7 ONLY** and from the **Norfolk, Virginia International Airport (code: ORF) ONLY**. The mandatory International Student Orientation will be held on **Thursday, August 9 and Friday, August 10** with special assistance offered for getting settled on **Wednesday, August 8**. If we are able to offer the airport pick-up service, all students will be notified by email in mid-July and there will be several airport pick-ups on those days based on the arrival information we receive. If we can provide this service and you do not submit your Arrival Form before July 15, 2012 we will not be able to assist you with airport transportation. (Note: All University offices are closed on Saturdays & Sundays, so assistance is not available on those days.
