

Regent University Student Alumni Ambassadors POINT SYSTEM OVERVIEW AND GUIDELINES

Purpose of the Point System

The point system for the Regent University Student Alumni Ambassadors is designed to govern Ambassador participation throughout the academic year.

Each semester Ambassadors can receive up to a \$300.00 stipend based on point acquisition. Additionally, to remain an Ambassador in good standing with the organization, each member must maintain minimum points per semester as determined by the advisor and SAA officers. If members fall below the minimum points per semester, the Ambassador shall be brought before the officers to decide whether or not the individual should remain in the organization.

Points system guidelines:

1. Members will earn three (3) points per hour worked
2. Members will obtain required hours to earn stipend (hours will be determined each semester by the advisor and the executive board)
3. Members must attend a minimum of three (3) Career Development workshops
4. Members must work a minimum of seven (7) events per semester
5. Members will lose $\frac{1}{4}$ of current accumulated points for the following infractions:
 - Member who is not in proper uniform, which includes official Student Alumni Ambassador name tag
 - Member who is tardy for their assigned time (i.e. five (5) minutes after assigned time is considered late)
 - Member who fails to show up for an assigned time

Fall 2006

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| Minimum points required to remain an Ambassador = | 75 points |
| Points required to receive $\frac{1}{2}$ stipend amount = | 76-108 points |
| Points required to receive full stipend amount = | 109-209 points |

Spring 2006

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| Minimum points required to remain an Ambassador = | 75 points |
| Points required to receive $\frac{1}{2}$ stipend amount = | 76-96 points |
| Points required to receive full stipend amount = | 96-188 points |
