## Regent Village Move-in Day Guide

Dear Resident:

We are excited about you joining (or re-joining) the Regent University residential community this August! Our staff wants to insure your move-in experience to our residence halls is a smooth and successful one. In anticipation of some questions you may have regarding the move-in process, please take a few moments to carefully review the information included below.

### **When can I move-in to my housing assignment in Regent Village?**

- **All new (first-year and transfer students)** will be able to start moving in at 8:00am on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017. New students may not move-in prior to this date/time. University staff members will be available in front of (weather permitting) or just inside of the Regent Village Community Building to welcome and assist you. The physical address for the Community Building is 5952 Jake Sears Circle; Virginia Beach, VA 23464. Residence Life staff members will be able to assist you with checking-in from 8:00am to 4:00pm on Wednesday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

\*\*\* Welcome Week events for first-year and transfer students begin at 4:30pm on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Be sure to plan accordingly based on your specified move-in timeframe. All new students should be moved in by no later than 4pm on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017. \*\*\*

- **All returning students** will be able to start moving in at 8:00am on Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Returning students may not move-in prior to this date/time. University staff members will be able to assist you with move-in from 8:00am to midnight on Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017, and from 8:00am to 5:00pm on Sunday, August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Location for check-in is the Regent Village Community Building (5952 Jake Sears Circle; Virginia Beach, VA 23464).

### **When, where, and how will I get the keys to my housing assignment?**

- When you arrive to campus you will need to come to Regent Village Community Building where University staff members will guide you through the check-in process. There will be signage directing students and their families to the Regent Village Community Building.

### **Where should I park to unload all of my stuff?**

- There should be ample parking near the specific apartment buildings in which undergraduate students will be living. Driving on sidewalks or on the grassy areas around the apartment buildings is prohibited.
- **We cannot strongly recommend enough that you rent or purchase a dolly or cart to transport belongings from your vehicle to the building.
