

## **BIBLEWORKS 6**

**Description:** *BibleWorks 6* is a fully interactive Bible concordance and exegesis program. It includes texts of the Hebrew Old Testament, Greek New Testament, New Testament, and a wide range of English and modern foreign language Bible texts. It also has Bible dictionaries and other exegetical aids.

**Access:** Available on the Library "Stand-Alone" pc in the reference area.

**Special Terms & Functions:** *BibleWorks 6* offers a choice of three different modes for searching: 1. A **Beginner Mode** that uses a menu-driven, step-by-step approach; 2. A **Standard Mode** with a "Command Line" where you enter the verses or words you want to look up and dropdown list boxes to fine-tune your search; 3. A **Power User Mode** where you have the option of using "Control" characters in the Command Line to tell *BibleWorks* what to do with your search terms.

**Printing:** Highlight and copy the desired text. Open *Notepad* by clicking on the computer "Start" button, then go to "Programs," "Accessories," and "*Notepad*." Paste your selected text into *Notepad* and use the web browser print function.

**E-mail:** Highlight and copy the desired text. Open any web-based e-mail program in a new browser, and paste the selected text into an e-mail message.

**Help:** Click on the "Help" button or "Run Videos" on the initial screen to view sample searches.

**Steps to Research:** Click on *BibleWorks 6* from the main menu of the Stand-Alone pc and the yellow "Which Command Center Layout do you want to use?" window displays. Click on the "Beginner Mode" radio button, close out the yellow window, then click on the "Search" button at the lower right and follow the five steps in the "Easy Search Dialog" window.

1. Select a Bible version; 2. Enter the words you want to find; 3. Choose the type of search you wish to perform; 4. Choose how you wish to display the results; and, 5. Click on the "Find the verses" button. The resulting verse citations display in the tall narrow verse citation box to the right and the text of the verses display in the large *BibleWorks* window to the left. Move from one verse to the next by clicking on the verse citation in the verse citation box.

Click on the square entirely-yellow icon on the top toolbar and open the Standard Mode layout. Locate a narrow horizontal box on the lower right next to the word, "Go." This is the "Command Line." Click inside the box and type a search word such as, "grace." Click on "Go" and your text results display in the window to the left. Move the cursor over any of the words in the text and the corresponding Hebrew or Greek words display in the bottom left-hand window.
