

Columbia International Affairs Online

Description: *Full-Text.* Indexes and provides access to working papers, current issues of select journals, books, policy briefs and much more.

Access: Go to the Library's "Databases" web page, and select Columbia International Affairs Online (CIAO).

Special Terms & Functions: You may search by topics provided; for example by clicking on working papers an alphabetic listing of paper titles appears. CIAO may be searched by using key words. To assist in this search the user may select to search in working papers, journals, policy briefs, books, case studies or all in all areas.

Printing – Use the print from your browser tool bar or under file. Articles that are in PDF format please use the printer option within the PDF screen.

Email – This database base does not offer the option to email articles to your email address.

Steps to Research: Users may browse CIAO by clicking on topics in the left hand column. Topics include working papers, journals, books, policy briefs, or case studies.

Working papers, journals, policy briefs, books or case studies may be searched individually or in any combination in the basic or advanced search options. This may be accomplished by clicking the boxes next to the topics. Basic searching allows the subjects to be changed by clicking on the arrow down key next to all subjects. CIAO is searchable over the past five years and may be changed by clicking on the arrow down key next to all dates. Subject of interest may be entered in the box below the date box and then click search. Results list of articles, 25 at a time, are retrieved if search is successful. In order to view articles, click on the title.

Advanced search allows words to be searched in the body, title, author's name or contributing institution's name. Boolean operators in the form of and, or, not assist the researcher narrow down the topic. Advanced search also allows the ability to search only working papers, journals, books, policy briefs and case studies or in any combination. . Subject of interest may be entered in the box below the date box and then click search. Results list of articles, 25 at a time, are retrieved if search is successful. In order to view articles, click on the title.

Mark Records – This database does not allow individual articles to be marked.

Source List – A list of sources may be found under site index. Each article is footnoted.
