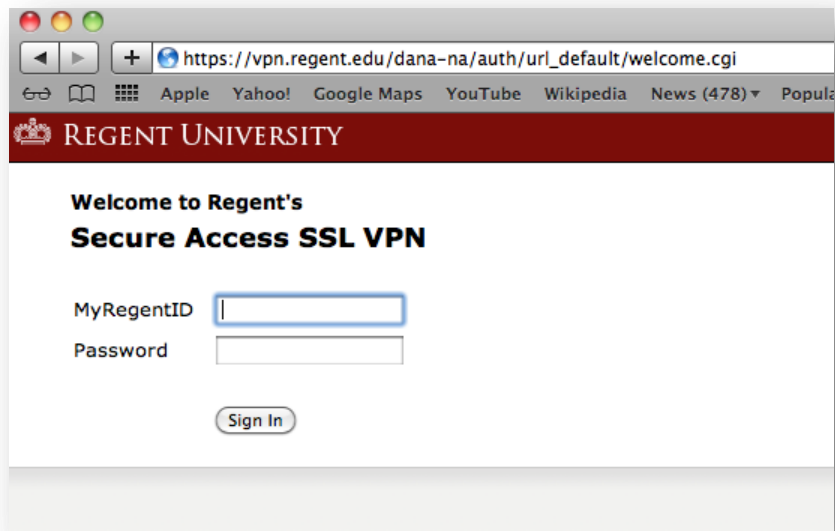


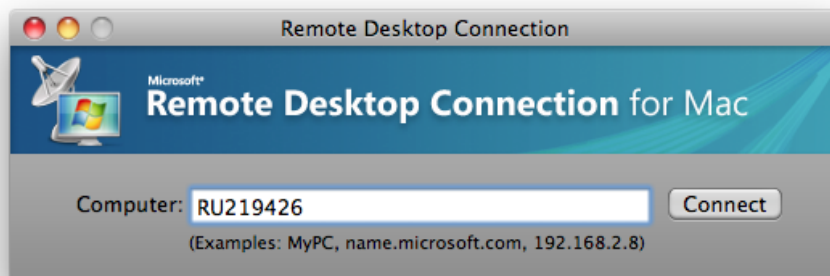
Running Remote Desktop from a Mac

To use Remote Desktop from a Mac you will first need to download and install the Remote Desktop Client for Mac. The program can be found and installed from [here](#).


Once you have installed the Remote Desktop Client you will need to log into VPN by going to vpn.regent.edu.



After you have signed into VPN and network connect is running you will need to open the Remote Desktop Client for Mac and type in your computer number starting with "RU" (example. *RU219426*). If you are connecting to a Terminal Server type the name of the server (example. *termsrv1*). Then click **connect**.



On the next window, type in your MyRegent ID and password. Under Domain type **regent.edu**. You can check the box to have your computer remember this information so you do not need to input it every time. Once that is done click **ok** and you will soon see your desktop.
