In order for F-1 international students to maintain their lawful immigration status, they are required to be enrolled full-time (generally 12 credit hours for undergraduates, 9 credit hours for graduate students, 6 credits for doctoral students, and 10 credits for law students) during each fall and spring semester. There are a few exceptions to the full-time rule, which the Office of International Students Services (OISS) must first approve for immigration purposes. These exceptions are listed below and must be recommended by the appropriate academic representative before the OISS can approve them. If you are able to verify that this student meets any of the exceptions listed below, please complete this section and return the form to the student as soon as possible.
