IMPORTANT: Please attach a copy of your most recent LES or DD-214.**Requirements/Criteria:**

- 1) Full-semester students receive \$1,000 annually, split between fall and spring semesters; 8-week Online and 8-week On-campus student receive \$250 per semester, including optional summer semesters.
- 2) Full-semester students must enroll full-time (12 or more credits per semester); 8-week Online and 8-week On-campus students must enroll at least half time (6 or more credits per semester).
- 3) Applicants must be the spouse or child of an active duty, reservist, or veteran military service member.
- 4) Eligible applicants must maintain good academic standing in order to maintain eligibility.
- 5) Veteran status includes those who have been issued a DD-214 with a discharge status other than "Dishonorable".
- 6) This award may be combined with other Regent-funded scholarships or grants. Note: students may combine up to three (3) non-merit, Regent-funded grants or a maximum of \$1,500 institutional dollars with merit-based scholarships, whichever comes first.
