

# ***PACE at a Glance***

## ***What course am I taking?***

BIBL 175 Special Topics in Biblical Studies is a one-credit undergraduate course that offers guidance on how to read, interpret, and apply the Holy Scriptures.

## ***What will I learn?***

The Regent University Statement of Faith asserts "that the Holy Bible is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative source of Christian doctrine and precept." This understanding forms the basis for how this course will teach the reading, interpretation, and application of the Bible. A proper understanding of God's special revelation to mankind rightly equips Christian leaders to engage with a fallen world and to participate in God's redemptive plan for humanity.

## ***What will I do?***

In this course, you will learn primarily through reading articles and essays and viewing video presentations. All of these materials are in Blackboard and easily accessible. The course is four weeks in length with a section for each week. You will also notice that there is a Week 0: Getting Started section; this section will help you become acquainted with online learning, Blackboard, and Regent-specific resources.

There are two basic types of graded assignments in this course: discussion forums and a final paper. There are 3 discussion forums in which you will be asked to answer questions and to share your responses with classmates. In addition, there is a final paper which you will submit twice: once, as a draft, and then as a final version. As this is a one-credit course, you should be prepared to spend about 11 hours per week on reading, viewing, studying, and completing assignments.

## ***When will I do it?***

You will have something to do each week. Here is a brief overview (check the Syllabus and Blackboard for due dates and more details):
