Instructions (Applicants/Senior Naval Science Instructors)

1. Visit our website: <https://umaine.edu/navalrotc/njrotc-pathways-to-engineering-npe/>
2. **Applicants:** Download the NPE application form, save the form locally to your computer.
3. **Senior Naval Science Instructors:** Download the Senior Naval Science Instructor recommendation form, as well as the Physical Fitness Assessment, and save the forms locally to your computer.
4. Open the forms in Adobe Reader. Adobe Reader is available free from this website: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
5. Start typing your information into the document. Note: write your essays in Microsoft Word first so that you can spell check them. Then, cut and paste them into the application. Max allowed essay length is approximately one page, single-spaced in Microsoft Word. Ensure your entire essay is visible in the form when printed. When complete, print and sign form using pen.
6. Applicants: Scan the signed document and forward it along with all other required documents (see checklist above) to michael.flanagan1@maine.edu and sheryl.hill@maine.edu.
7. Senior Naval Science Instructors: scan and send the signed documents to michael.flanagan1@maine.edu and sheryl.hill@maine.edu

Deadlines

- 20 December 2018 – Applications are due to the University of Maine ***and NROTC***.
- 01 February 2019 – Applicants will be notified if they are selected.
- 04 February 2019 – Non-selected applicants will be notified.
- 01 March 2019 – FAFSA Applications are due.
- 01 May 2019 – Awardee signing day. (Maine day!)
