Regent University Navy ROTC Preparatory Scholarship

Congratulations again on earning the Regent University Navy ROTC Preparatory Scholarship. To officially join the Navy ROTC Preparatory Program at Regent University, you must accept the terms and conditions of this scholarship by signing and returning Page 1 and Page 2 to military@regent.edu as soon as possible (preferably within 7 days):

[] Acceptance of this award requires fulltime enrollment of 12+ credit hours for both the fall and spring semesters and does not apply to the summer semester. Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.8 and must remain in good academic standing.

[] This scholarship requires that students pursue an on-campus undergraduate program (Bachelor's program) through the College of Arts & Sciences and reside in the residence halls for the duration of the preparatory program as well as the follow-on years as a NROTC student. Housing funds are only applicable to charges within the Regent University Commons Residence Halls.

[] Acceptance of this scholarship results in the forfeiture of all other institutional scholarships for the 2019-2020 academic year during participation in the Navy ROTC Preparatory Program and for any subsequent term for which student receives an ROTC Scholarship from the United States Navy.

[] Acceptance of this scholarship requires that the student attends and successfully completes New Student Indoctrination (NSI) in Great Lakes, IL from July 3rd- 24th or July 25th – August 15th, 2019.

[] Acceptance of this scholarship requires that the student attends and completes Regent's Summer Orientation, Advising & Registration (SOAR) on June 21st -22nd or June 24th -25th, 2019. Student is also expected to actively participate in all NROTC activities during the 2019-2020 academic year.
