Dear Chancellor Robertson,

I am pleased to hear that Regent University will support seven to ten annual Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps (NROTC) Preparatory (NP) scholarships to potential Midshipmen in the NROTC program. The Navy is committed to continuing the education of these individuals with an offer of a follow-on four-year NROTC Scholarship to Regent University.

Once notified and approved by the Hampton Roads Professor of Naval Science by 1 May of each year, the Navy will reserve up to ten four year NROTC scholarships for the Regent NP program. The scholarship reservations will become scholarship offers once candidates successfully complete Regent's 10 month preparation program to include obtaining medical clearance, passing the Navy's Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA), achieving at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA, agreeing to the terms of the scholarship contract, and receiving the Professor of Navy Science's recommendation. I am confident participants in Regent's NP program will be motivated and will meet these requirements.

I have directed the Hampton Roads Professor of Naval Science to keep us both apprised of the progress of these future Midshipmen. I look forward to continuing our strong relationship in education and developing future Naval Officers for the United States Navy.
