Effective Fall 2022

PhD students must complete a total of 60 credit hours within 7 years as follows:

- 36 credit hours of core courses
- 12 credit hours of concentration elective courses
- 4 units of comprehensive exams
- 12 credit hours of dissertation courses

¹ Block 1 must begin with LPHD 751. Students may take LPHD751 with one other Block 1 course. All courses in Block 1 must be successfully completed prior to taking courses in Block 2.

² Block 2 must begin with LPHD 754. Students may take LPHD 754 concurrently with their last Block 1 course.

³ Students must complete all core courses before taking elective courses. However, the first elective course of Block 3 may be taken concurrently with the last core course of Block 2.

⁴ LPHD 785 is a culminating core course that may be taken no sooner than the last of the elective courses.

⁵ At the successful completion of all PhD core and elective coursework (cumulative GPA 3.0), students proceed to comprehensive exams. Each comprehensive exam unit is offered as an 8-week unit. LPHD 801 and LPHD 802 must be taken concurrently. LPHD 803 and LPHD 804 must be taken concurrently. As non-credit bearing units, enrolling in comprehensive exams, does not qualify as continuous enrollment required at this stage in the doctoral program. Thus, students are required to also register for LPHD 861 (3) during the first semester of their comprehensive exams. Students who require more than one semester to successfully complete their comprehensive exam are required to register for subsequent dissertation courses (LPHD 862, 863, 864, and 865).

⁶ As stated above, students are required to begin registering for dissertation credits immediately following the successful completion of all required coursework (Blocks 1-3). Students must register for LPHD 865 (1) continuing dissertation credit after completion of all required 12 dissertation credits (LPHD 861-863) and until successful final defense of the dissertation.
