

WHAT SHOULD I BRING TO CAMPUS?

All furnished housing assignments for traditional age undergraduates (18-24), non-traditional age undergraduates (25+), and graduate students include the following: extra-long twin bed (*traditional age*) OR queen bed (*non-traditional age and graduates*), desk, desk chair, dresser drawers, TV stand, drop-leaf table and chairs, sofa, blinds, closet, refrigerator/freezer, microwave (*Regent Commons only*), stove/oven, dishwasher, and garbage disposal. All provided furniture and appliances cannot be removed from the housing assignment. **Please be advised that storage is not provided in the residence halls.**

YOU MUST BRING:

- ✓ Linens (sheets, comforter, pillow cases)
- ✓ Pillows
- ✓ Towels/washcloths
- ✓ Toilet paper
- ✓ First Aid kit
- ✓ Cleaning supplies
- ✓ Shower curtain & liner
- ✓ Dishes and eating utensils
- ✓ Laundry detergent

WE RECOMMEND YOU BRING:

- ✓ Bible
- ✓ Computer/Laptop
- ✓ TV
- ✓ Video game systems
- ✓ Microwave (Regent Village only)
- ✓ Toaster, coffee maker, blender, and other small kitchen appliances
- ✓ Mattress cover
- ✓ Power strips (must have reset button)
- ✓ Vacuum cleaner and kitchen mop
- ✓ Laundry basket
- ✓ Clothes hangers
- ✓ Iron and ironing board
- ✓ Bike and lock (outside racks provided)
- ✓ Trash can and bags
- ✓ Tension rod and window curtains
- ✓ Small nails, tacks, or picture hangers for wall decorations
- ✓ Umbrella
- ✓ Anything that will make your room feel more like home!

DO NOT BRING:*

- X Firearms, ammunition, fireworks, explosives, or weapons of any kind (including but not limited to Taser guns, BB/pellet guns, airsoft guns, paintball guns, Nerf guns, throwing stars, switchblade knives, nunchucks, etc.)
- X Alcoholic beverages (including empties) and paraphernalia
- x Tobacco products and paraphernalia
- x Vapes, E-Cigarettes, and similar products and paraphernalia
- x Wireless routers
- x Candles, wax warmers, and incense
- X Pets (except fish in freshwater tanks no larger than 5 gallons)
- X Extension cords, multi-plug adapters, outlet splitters, or plug-in air fresheners with additional outlets
- x Fog machines
- x Darts and dart boards
- x Space heaters
- x Wallpaper (including borders)
- x Homemade lofts, stilts, or cinderblocks
- x Traffic Signs
- x Pressurized containers (CO2, propane)
- x Fuels (kerosene, gasoline, propane)
