The scholarships that are made available to these emerging scholars offset the costs affiliated with attending a private institution like Regent and open the door to a world-class Christian education, regardless of a student's economic background.

Now, perhaps more than ever, Regent University is faced with the growing needs of students who rely on scholarship assistance. We want to insure that every student who desires an education at Regent is not hindered due to financial obstacles. Providing a scholarship for a deserving student is one way that you can help develop *Christian Leadership to Change the World*.

In addition, since the average tuition and fees cover only 52 percent of the cost of a Regent education, the remaining amount must come from the generous gifts of alumni, friends and corporations. Your gift to special funds or initiatives will enhance the Regent experience for our students.

Annual Cost of Attendance (by School)

Listed below are the average estimated tuition and fees for students to complete one academic year of study, as categorized by Regent University's seven graduate schools and the School of Undergraduate Studies. These estimates do not include books, housing and other living/ancillary expenses.

All donors who answer this important challenge and elect to provide a student scholarship may designate their gift in a variety of ways. The most common forms of scholarship support are outlined below.

Named Scholarships

Providing a named scholarship is a wonderful way to honor or memorialize a loved one, friend or colleague while recognizing and helping deserving Regent students pursue their education. Such scholarships can also be named by a group or for a special program that is meaningful to you. Many of our named scholarships were established by individuals, corporations and Regent alumni who received tuition aid during their time as a student. A named scholarship can be endowed or annually renewed.

Endowed Scholarships

An endowed scholarship represents a fund in which the donated amounts are invested, and a student's education is funded by the interest earned. There are many ways to endow a scholarship, such as:

- ▶ Providing a contribution of \$25,000 or more to establish a fund, which is invested, with the proceeds distributed to deserving students. A full-tuition scholarship is made possible with an endowed fund of \$350,000 or more.
- ▶ Contributing to a previously established endowed scholarship in order to increase the principal of the fund, producing more annual income for scholarship distribution.
- ▶ Joining with a number of other donors to create a new endowed scholarship fund.

Funds can be established to cover a percentage of a student's tuition or to meet comprehensive needs, including stipends for living expenses.

Regent University currently supports over 90 endowed scholarships, including the Robertson Endowed Honors Scholarship, named for Regent's founder, Dr. M.G. "Pat" Robertson. This award is made each year to scholars who exemplify the highest character, leadership and scholastic ability.



This scholarship, Regent's most prestigious, covers tuition costs and provides a generous stipend.

Providing an endowed scholarship not only benefits today's students, but also generations of Regent students who will obtain an outstanding Christian education because of your foresight and generosity.

Annually Renewed Scholarships

In addition to the provision of endowed funds, a scholarship can also be established by gifts that are not invested but used in their entirety to help deserving students. Funding an annually renewed scholarship allows you to maximize the short-term impact of your gift, but your fund may be replenished for as many years as desired.

The Dean's Fund for Excellence

Each Regent school provides a distinctive and specialized educational experience. Because many of our students have

unique circumstances, the Dean's Fund for Excellence allows the dean of each school to identify deserving students who need financial assistance in order to pursue their studies at Regent. Your gift can be designated to support such students or for the greatest need within that school.

Our students begin their Regent experience with academic potential and a strong desire to fulfill their God-given purposes. The establishment of Regent scholarships gives them the financial support they need to pursue their education, and empowers these men and women to fulfill their unique mission to change the world. By establishing a new scholarship or providing additional support to an existing scholarship fund, you provide a significant means of advancing Christian leadership in our nation and around the world for generations to come.
