General Notes

- ➤ Check Degree Works or the Catalog for course pre-requisite information.
- Minimum C- grade for major coursework required
- > 50% of major requirements must be taken at Regent University
- A minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to maintain good academic standing.
- > Some majors also require a minimum grade in all major courses.
- As a general rule, 100 and 200 level courses should be taken prior to upper level (300 and 400) level courses.
- > A minimum of 63 credits is required.

Major Related Notes

- The Biblical & Theological Studies major is offered on campus and online.
- ➤ BIBL 200 and BIBL 220 are prerequisites for many required courses for the major. It is best to take both courses at the first opportunity, for example right after taking preparatory Gen Ed courses UNIV 100 (online students) and GENE 100.
