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*For the Student-Designed concentration a student may petition to design his or her own concentration field. The concentration must be made up of 15 credit hours at the 300-400 level, all within the same discipline. The student will submit a petition with the proposed courses and a rationale for why the self-designed concentration field is the best option for the student's chosen career path. Self-designed emphases must be approved by the student's academic advisor and the Chair of the Business, Leadership, and Management department.

General Notes

- Check Degree Works or the Catalog for course pre-requisite information.
- Minimum C- grade for major coursework required
- 50% of major requirements must be taken at Regent University
- A minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to maintain good academic standing.
- Some majors also require a minimum grade in all major courses.
- As a general rule, 100 and 200 level courses should be taken prior to upper level (300 and 400) level courses.
- A minimum of 120 credits is required.
- A minor may be completed in place of a portion of the general electives. Students must still earn 120 credits total.
- Honors & on campus students will have 15 less gen. elec. credits due to taking the C&C minor or Honors courses.

Major Related Notes

- All LDST courses except LDST 330 and LDST 370 have a prerequisite of LDST 201.
- For students pursuing the Business concentration, BUSN 320 has a prerequisite of ECON 120. Additionally, BUSN 470 has prerequisites of ACCT 205, BUSN 240, and BUSN 320.
- For students pursuing the Christian Ministry concentration, BIBL 220 has a prerequisite of BIBL 200. Additionally, BIBL 322 and BIBL 373 have prerequisites of BIBL 200 and BIBL 220.
- For students pursuing the American Government/Public Policy concentration, GOVT 300, GOVT 301, and GOVT 302 have a prerequisite of GOVT 240.
- For students pursuing the Information Technology concentration, ISYS 302 and ISYS 321 have a prerequisite of ISYS 204. Additionally, ISYS 317 has a prerequisite of ISYS 214.
- This program is only offered online.
- All LDST courses except LDST 201, LDST 250, LDST 330, LDST 425, LDST 435, & LDST 440 are offered only once a year. Please reference the Course Planning Tool to verify the semester each course is offered.
