General Notes

- > Check Degree Works or the Catalog for course pre-requisite information.
- Minimum C- grade for major coursework required
- > 50% of major requirements must be taken at Regent University
- A minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA is required to maintain good academic standing.
- Some majors also require a minimum grade in all major courses.
- As a general rule, 100 and 200 level courses should be taken prior to upper level (300 and 400) level courses.
- A minimum of 120 credits is required.
- A minor may be completed in place of a portion of the general electives. Students must still earn 120 credits total.
- Honors & on campus students will have 15 less general elective credits due to taking the C&C minor or Honors courses.

Major Related Notes

- > This major is offered Online only.
- This major does not lead to a teacher license in Virginia. The B.Ed. in Early and Primary Education (PK-3) is an alternative major, offered on-campus, for those who wish to be fully licensed by the end of their degree program.
- Students should take UIS 200 Orientation to Teaching during their first year.
- > UEC 480 Practicum is a non-paid field experience completed in an approved childcare setting in the student's final semester. Students log 90 practicum hours and complete associated assignments related to the practice of teaching.
- ➤ UEC 421, UEC 439, and UEC 440 are only offered in Fall terms.
- COMM 240, UEC 406, UEC 441, UEC 444, UEC 446, and UEC 451 are only offered in Spring terms.
