¹ Must be completed during first semester of enrollment.

² All doctoral students must attend this 3-credit hour on-campus seminar, which is scheduled for one week.

³ Doctoral students meet the residency requirement by completing annual required residencies starting in their first semester and for each Academic year thereafter in which they still are completing credits. Students who finish coursework prior to summer are not required to participate in a residency that year. These residencies coincide with COM 700, COM 730 and either COM 703 or COM 785.

* These are recommended electives, however, please consult with academic advisor for other options. 6 credits of advanced standing can reduce the amount of elective credits based on a recently earned Masters' Degree in a field in the discipline.

⁴ Doctoral students will be given the opportunity to collaborate with faculty on teaching classes and conducting scholarly research. Students can receive doctoral credit for this collaboration by enrolling in COM 791 Doctoral Mentoring: Pedagogy (1-3) or COM 792 Doctoral Mentoring: Research & Writing (1-3). Recommended elective course.

⁵ Minimum 52 credit hours must be completed before the qualifying examination. Students must complete a minimum of three credit hours of qualifying exam.

⁶ Minimum of 9 credit hours of COM 799 dissertation research over 3 semesters required.
