Notes

1 Post-master's and doctoral Education students will take UNIV LIB if they score a 6 on the criterion admissions writing sample. If students do not score a 6, they must enroll in EDU 600 their first semester of post-master's coursework.

2 Independent Study with a SOE professor. These independent study hours shall be used to focus on research collaboration in the faculty member's area of interest. Student may receive 1-6 credit hours for course.

4 Students who have not defended their dissertation after completing EFND 906A, B, & C are required to take EFND 907 Dissertation Continuation (3 credits) each term until either they successfully defend or their time limit has been reached.
