**Graduation Requirements**

Complete 33 credit hours.  
 Degree must be completed within 5 years.  
 Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 .  
 Only core courses in which a student receives a **C or better** will count toward a degree or certificate in the Robertson School of Government.

The limit for the number of credits accepted by Advanced Standing and transfer is forty-nine percent of total degree requirements, which for the MA in Campaigns and Political Leadership program is 16 credit hours.

<sub>1</sub>Students are registered for GOV 501 based on their admissions writing sample score. Students are required to take UNIV LIB but that course is waived if a student successfully completes GOV 501.

<sub>2</sub>Recommended to take during first or second semester.
